



The Road to Certification - Overview

•Step 1 - Log in to your All Access Pass Portal (https://link.allaccesspass.com/)

•Step 2 – From the 'Explore Solutions' section, click on the title of the course you're getting certified in.

•Step 3 – Click on the 'Facilitating' tab at the top of the page (Users need 'Facilitator' access to view this section. Heres a tutorial for <u>'Changing User Role'</u> as a Client Admin.)

•Step 4 - Electronically agree to the Facilitator License Agreement

- •Step 5 Click 'Launch Certification Videos' videos, then:
 - View these videos once as a participant with your Participant Guide*
 - View them again with your 'facilitator hat' on with your **Facilitator Guide**, taking notes, preparing stories and examples, and making sure your audience can connect to the course

•**Step 6** – Download your PowerPoints from the **'Facilitating'** tab and schedule a practice teach with colleagues. You could also record yourself on MS Teams or WebEx.

•Step 7 – Get your certificate of certification! Simply e-mail <u>vacare@franklincovey.com</u> with your first and last name, VISN, facility, and course(s) that you've completed certification for.

 - Jot down contingency plans to help you in a time crunch (e.g., on p. X, if time is short just have participants complete Application Exercise questions #1 and #3.)
- Do a practice session for 2-3 colleagues
